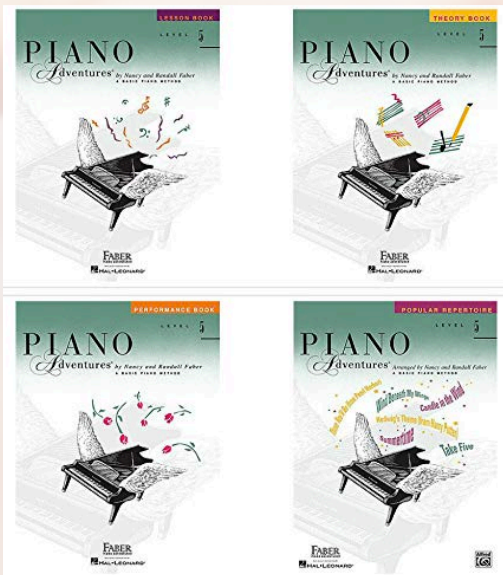
Class Overview:

Description

Level 5 is a student bridge to the great piano repertoire. The level promotes strong recognition of harmony in many keys. Technique is guided with a focus on scales and arpeggios—playing these fluidly and tension free. Students study pieces by Clementi, Burgmüller, and Bach, among others. Folk tunes with active L.H. accompaniments, such as “Shenandoah,” mingle with jazz and blues standards.
